

#### **HPP FUNDING**



### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- California (CA) continued developing its infectious disease response plans, which involved coordinating with emergency medical services (EMS) partners to develop transportation plans for each of the mutual aid regions in the state.
- CA's Medical and Health Coordination Center (MHCC) coordinated with CA Emergency Support Function 8 (ESF-8) partners and stakeholders to provide a comprehensive overview of statewide wildfire response efforts.

## SPOTLIGHT ON RESPONSE

The CA Department of Public Health (CDPH) managed concurrent crises in 2020. As the first state to respond to COVID-19, CA stood up several Federal Medical Stations and alternate care sites (ACS) to accommodate surges in positive cases. Meanwhile, CA's Medical and Health Coordination Center (MHCC) was activated at level 1 (high) in response to wildfires in August 2020. HPP funding supported CA's response through preestablished health care coalition (HCC) partnerships and communication pathways.

### **COVID-19 RESPONSE**

- State and local counties assisted with early federal COVID-19 quarantine operations at military bases in CA by providing personal protective equipment (PPE).
- The CDPH supported infection prevention staff deployment, call centers, resource requests, laboratory testing, and advanced planning.
- The CDPH and the CA Emergency Medical Services Authority helped stand up Federal Medical Stations with a combined surge potential of >2,000 beds, and ACS with a combined potential of >3,000 beds.
